The Ministry of International Relations and Cooperation presents its compliments to All Heads of Diplomatic Missions, International and Regional Organizations and Consular Representatives accredited to the Republic of Namibia and has the honour to forward a Public Notice No: 4/2022, dated 22 March 2022, issued by the Ministry of Health and Social Services, regarding the **Clarification of a “Fully vaccinated” status as an entry requirement into Namibia.**

“Persons permitted to enter Namibia under sub-regulation (2) to enter if such persons at the time of entering Namibia present to an authorized person a valid vaccination certificate showing that the persons concerned are fully vaccinated against COVID-19; and the vaccination certificate is issued by a person or authority certified or authorized to administer COVID-19 vaccines and to issue vaccination certificates in any country”.

Therefore, the Ministry would like to clarify and inform the public that an individual is considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 if:

- (a) An adult, 18 years and older, has received: (i) two (2) doses of a two-dose regimen vaccine, or (ii) one (1) dose of a one-dose regimen vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson vaccine, 14 days prior to the date of entry into Namibia.
- (b) Children and adolescents 12 years and older should meet the requirement in (a) above, as the case may be.
- (c) A booster vaccine is not a requirement for entry into Namibia.

Please note:

- Children 5-≤12 years should present negative SARS-Cov2-PCR test results.
- The vaccination certificate and negative SARS-Cov2-PCR test result requirements do not apply to children ≤5 years old.

The Ministry of International Relations and Cooperation avails itself of this opportunity to renew to All Heads of Diplomatic Missions, International and Regional Organizations and Consular Representatives the assurances of its highest consideration.
